Hi Tara (and all),

We would work with the Planning Director to find the best person (or people) with robust knowledge of housing issues and with availability that evening. The length would likely depend on how many and what kind

of questions came up from the group. I would imagine we would want to

ask them to give a presentation in the 10-15 minute range and then be available for questions. The aim would be to provide a more detailed view of specific housing-related City initiatives already in place or planned and to be able to have someone there with expertise in the area to answer some of the more nuanced questions, such as the ones that came up at the last meeting. It seemed to us that there was general consensus among the group that this kind of presentation / Q&A would be appreciated, but there was no formal vote taken. We wanted to check with you if you all still thought that would be valuable. If not, or if you would like to postpone to a future meeting, we can certainly do that.
